Making the Grade

- By passing all classes students earn 30 credits a semester
 60 credits a year
- Semester grades are the only grades reported on a transcript
 Health and Driver's Ed from 9th grade are the <u>only</u> exceptions
- No credit is given for failed coursework
- Failed coursework is made up through alternate programs
 - Summer School, After School Credit Recovery

Lodi Unified High School Graduation Requirements

- Complete 230 credits to graduate *including* required academic coursework
- Successfully complete Algebra I or equivalent
 High School Math
 - Integrated Math I



Lodi Unified High School Academic Coursework Requirements

- 4 years of English
- 2 years of Math Including Algebra or equivalent
- 2 years of Science 1 Physical and 1 Life
- 1 year of VAPA <u>or</u> LOTE <u>or</u> CTE VAPA: Visual and Performing Arts LOTE: Language Other Than English CTE: Career Technical Education

- ♦ 1 year of World History
- ✤ 1 year of US History
- 1 Semester of Government
- 1 Semester of Economics
- ✤ Electives to 230 credits

 - Available for Juniors and Seniors only




Work Experience

- Must be work permit eligible or over age 18
- Must be employed
- Must be able to attend weekly, after school seminar
- 180 hours/semester = 5 <u>Elective</u> credits


Dual Enrollment <u>or</u> College Early Start
<u>San Joaquin Delta College</u>
3 Delta credits = 10 Tokay <u>elective</u> credits
Must complete enrollment process, including application to SJDC, CES form





Building Your GPA

- GPA stands for Grade Point Average
- GPA transforms the letter grade into a numerical average:
 - A=4 B=3 C=2 D=1 F=0
- GPA is calculated by adding together the numerical average for all the grades earned, then dividing by the number of classes
 - AP/Honors courses are weighted with an additional numeric point earned for letter grades
 - A=5 B=4 C=3 D=1 F=0



A-G College Entrance Requirements (C's or better in all classes)

- English (CP or Higher)
 - 4 years
- Math (Math 1, Math 2, Math 3 minimum)
 - 3 years (4 recommended)
- Lab Sciences (Biology, and Chemistry <u>or</u> Physics)
 - 2 years (3 recommended)
- Social Sciences (World History, U.S. History, Govt/Econ)
 - 2 years
- ✤ Fine Art
 - 1 year
- ♦ Language Other Than English (LOTE)
 - 2 years (3 recommended)
 - Must be same language
- ✤ College Prep Elective
 - 1 year



Remember...

A grade of 'D' = <u>D</u>oes not count for College Entrance
