Tokay High School Graduation Requirements

English	4 Classes	40 Credits: One class each year
Social Science	3 Classes	30 Credits: <i>World History or European History (10) <u>and</u> U.S. History (10) <u>and</u> Government (5) / Economics (5)</i>
Math	2 Classes	20 Credits: Must pass Algebra I or Equivalent (<i>High School Math <u>or</u> Integrated Math I</i>)
Science	2 Classes	20 Credits: <i>One Physical <u>and</u> One Life</i>
PE	2 Classes	20 Credits: <i>2nd year may be waived, if all requirements met</i>
VAPA/LOTE/CTE	1 Class	10 Credits: <i>1 class from any of the 3 categories</i>
Electives	9 Classes	90 Credits, including: Frosh Requirement (10): <i>World Geography/Family Living + Health/Drivers Ed <u>or</u> Human Geography <u>or</u> Engineering <u>or</u> AVID 9</i>

- Earn 230 Credits
- Complete Academic Coursework (*Passing Grade: 60% (D-) or higher*)
- Complete Algebra Equivalent

California State University (CSU)/University of California (UC) Minimum admissions Requirements

English	4 classes	40 Credits
Social Studies 2 years/4 semesters of history/social science, including one year of US History or one semester of U.S. History and one semester of American Government and one year of World History/Cultures or Historical Geography including European History.	2 classes	20 Credits
Mathematics Must cover Alg I, Alg II and Geometry. Integrated Math I/II/III accepted.	3 classes(4 strongly recommended)	30 Credits
Science One Biological Lab Science and one physical lab science (Physics or Chemistry)	2 classes (4 strongly recommended)	20 Credits
LOTE (Language Other Than English) Language)	2 classes (3 strongly recommended)	20 Credits (In same
VAPA (Visual and Performing Arts)	1 class	10 Credits
College Prep Elective	1 class	10 Credits

ONLINE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Navigate to your [AERIES STUDENT PORTAL](#) * (You must be on LodiUSD wifi to access).
- 2) Log in using your [regular email Username and Password](#).
- 3) Find [CLASSES](#) tab along the top menu.
- 4) Select [COURSE REQUEST ENTRY](#) from the drop-down Menu.
- 5) To the right, locate the [FILTER COURSES](#) in the gray bar.
- 6) Under that, locate the drop down menu under [ALL COURSES](#) heading.
- 7) Beginning with [ENGLISH](#), select the course you plan on taking.
- 8) Work your way through each [REQUIRED SUBJECT](#), selecting the appropriate course.
- 9) When done with requirements, begin your [ELECTIVE COURSE](#) requests.
- 10) Please note, that after you select your primary request, you may click on the [BLUE LINK](#) that says [ADD ALTERNATE](#). You should select an alternate for every [ELECTIVE REQUEST](#).
- 11) When you have finished choosing your courses, press [SUBMIT](#).
- 12) A confirmation box will appear. To finalize your course requests, click on ["I UNDERSTAND THAT I NEED TO MEET WITH MY COUNSELOR TO CONFIRM ENROLLMENT"](#)
