## Tokay High School Graduation Requirements

| English | 4 Classes | 40 Credits: One class each year |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Social Science | 3 Classes | 30 Credits: World History or European History (10) and U.S. History (10) and Government (5) / Economics (5) |
| Math | 2 Classes | 20 Credits: Must pass Algebra I or Equivalent (High School Math or Integrated Math I) |
| Science | 2 Classes | 20 Credits: One Physical and One Life |
| PE | 2 Classes | 20 Credits: 2 nd year may be waived, if all requirements met |
| VAPALOTE/CIE | 1 Class | 10 Credits: 1 class from any of the 3 categories |
| Electives | 9 Classes | 90 Credits, including: <br> Frosh Requirement (10): World Geography/Family Living + Health/Drivers Ed or Human Geography or Engineering or AVID 9 |

## ONLINE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

1) Navigate to your AERIES STUDENT PORTAL * (You must be on Lodiusd wifi to access).
2) Log in using your regular email UserName and Password.
3) Find CLASSES tab along the top menu.
4) Select COURSE REQUEST ENTRY from the drop-down Menu.
5) To the right, locate the FILTER COURSES in the gray bar.
6) Under that, locate the drop down menu under ALL COURSES heading.
7) Beginning with ENGLISH, select the course you plan on taking.
8) Work your way through each REOUIRED SUBJECT, selecting the appropriate course.
9) When done with requirements, begin your ELECTIVE COURSE requests.
10) Please note, that after you select your primary request, you may click on the BLUE LINK that says ADD ALTERNATE. You should select an alternate for every ELECTIVE REQUEST.
11) When you have finished choosing your courses, press SUBMIT.
12) A confirmation box will appear. To finalize your course requests, click on "I UNDERSTAND THAT I NEED TO MEET WITH MY COUNSELOR TO CONFIRM ENROLLMENT."

Please note that you may ONLY SUBMIT ONCE. You cannot go back and revise your selections.
